#### CJ Thoroughbreds Enjoys Successful 2025 Season in Wyoming

Highlighted by strong finishes in four two-year-old Thoroughbred stakes offered in Wyoming this summer, CJ Thoroughbreds Wyoming Accredited homebreds are running to the winner's circle. The CJ Thoroughbreds stable has a record of four wins (three being stakes races), four seconds and one third in ten starts.

"We are very optimistic about the future of Wyoming horse racing and have been working on this opportunity since 2022," said CJ Thoroughbreds President Corey Johnsen. "We started with five mares, and it is gratifying to watch their foals compete with success as two-year-olds. We have expanded with the purchase and accreditation of mares and now stand a top stallion prospect in graded stakes winning Dennis' Moment."

Johnsen's Wyoming roots actually go back more than 10 years. Along with longtime friend and partner Eugene Joyce, he was part of the group that lobbied for legislation to allow for historical horse racing in the state. The revenues generated from that type of wagering has revolutionized Wyoming horse racing and breeding. In 2024, the Wyoming breeders program produced more than \$8.5 million in awards for accredited state-breds. With the growth of border gaming facilities, which will attract tourists to Wyoming, breeders awards could top \$10 million per year, which makes it one of the richest programs in America.

Bobby Chancelot was the first winner with a six length victory in the Wyoming Bred Thoroughbred Futurity at Energy Downs. Then, Two Steves was successful in the John Schiffer Memorial Stakes at Energy Downs and the Wyoming-bred Futurity at Wyoming Downs. Bobby Chancelot finished a close second in the \$63,500 Bill Hartack Thoroughbred Futurity at Wyoming Downs on July 26.



CJ Thoroughbreds is committed to horse racing in Wyoming with more than 20 mares and foals in the Wyoming Accredited program. Dennis' Moment, who stood this season at Rodeo Ranch outside of Cheyenne, has foals on the ground and a promising group of mares in foal, which can be seen at **Jack Sims Ranch in Evanston**.
